- Premiums are payable only once per class if rider uses more than one horse. Highest earned premium will be paid.
- Youth entrants must be in by 8 p.m. on Thursday of the fair. Horses must be stalled in the horse barn for the entire fair. Entries will be released at 6 p.m. on Sunday. Stalls must be cleaned and checked before leaving.
- Non-compliance of any fair, barn or show rules may result in forfeiture of premiums earned of expulsion.
